Herman Miller is now incorporating more recycled content into the design, lowering the chair's overall carbon footprint by up to 17% compared to the previous version of Mirra 2. The nylon base and spine are now made from 100% recycled material. The expected reduction in the carbon footprint of the

updated Mirra 2 portfolio is equivalent to greenhouse gas emissions from driving 4.7 million miles in an average gasoline-powered passenger vehicle or the amount of energy needed to charge 121 million fully depleted smartphones and maintain that full charge throughout the day.
